Assembly Registration

WELCOME TO ABBOTSFORD!

The Lower Mainland churches of Mennonite Church British Columbia welcome you to Abbotsford!

Located in the heart of BC's Fraser Valley, Abbotsford is easily accessible. The Abbotsford International Airport (YXX) is Western Canada's fastest growing airport with connecting and non-stop flights to most major destinations across Canada. The city is one hour from Vancouver via the Trans-Canada Highway.

Abbotsford offers a comfortable west coast climate. Framed by the Fraser Valley and massive land areas, the city provides visitors with a diverse array of outdoor adventures and city experiences. Attractions include white water rafting, sturgeon fishing, hot-springs, camping, mountain-top hiking, biking, golfing, theme parks, tours and samples of homegrown products at many local farms, and scenic gardens. The Assembly meetings and activities for all ages will take place at the Mennonite Educational Institute (www.meisoc.com), 4081 Clearbrook Road. Shuttle service is available between MEI and the Assembly hotels (see Lodging section). The MEI campus has over 200 parking spaces for those with their own vehicles.

All of the meeting rooms at MEI are air-conditioned. Please bring an umbrella as you will need to go outside to move between meeting spaces, and the weather in BC in July can be wet. On-site shuttle service is available for those who have difficulty walking longer distances. Please also bring a reusable coffee mug and/or water bottle to reduce the number of disposable cups used at the Assembly.

Detailed information will be available in the delegate package you will receive upon arrival at the Assembly and at the Assembly information centre located in the main display area.

CHILDREN AND JUNIOR YOUTH

Hey kids! Come with us on a journey to discover how God's church is built to last! Through worship, crafts, songs, stories and all kinds of activities, see how all of us, no matter how small or how big, are a part of God's plan. All kids from infants to those who are entering grade 9 are invited to attend the Kids' Assembly.



The age groups are as follows:

- **Nursery (N)** – up to 3 years (not yet toilet trained) – Parents to supply bottles, food and diapers for their children
- **Pre-school (PS)** – 3 to 5 years (entering Kindergarten in fall of 2007)
- **Elementary (E)** – entering grades 1 to 6 in fall of 2007
- **Junior Youth (JY)** – entering grades 7 to 9 in fall of 2007

Helpful hints for parents:

- Kids will begin each day by worshipping together with their parents and the rest of the delegate and youth assemblies.
- Kids' Assembly activities will take place after morning worship until supper time.
- Parents are responsible for bringing their children to the Kids' Assembly location after the morning worship services.
- Parents are responsible for their children during all meal times.
- Child care is offered during the evening worship services, but no formal activities will take place.
- Junior Youth are invited to worship with the youth assembly in the evening.

The cost per child up to and including Jr. Youth is \$45.00. All pre-registered children will receive a welcome letter with more details.

YOUNG ADULTS

WORSHIP

A full selection of seminars will be offered on Wednesday and Friday from 1:15 to 2:30 PM for everyone to attend. The annual Ministers' Conference is extending an invitation to all those interested in financial stewardship issues to come together for a one day workshop on “Putting Your Money Where Your Faith Is”.

Gary Hawton, CEO of Meritas Mutual Funds, will give a keynote presentation. John H. Neufeld, Professor Emeritus and retired President of Canadian Mennonite Bible College (now Canadian Mennonite University), will offer theological reflections. Mennonite Foundation of Canada, Mennonite Church Canada pension plan consultants Belton and Grom, and SHARE (Shareholder Association for Research and Education) will offer workshops.

A. Abbotsford Airport

TOURS THURSDAY, JULY 5

A number of guided tours of the Abbotsford area have been arranged. See below for descriptions. Tours will start at 1:00 pm and return prior to 5:00 pm. Shuttle cost is included in the cost of the tour.

Tour 1 – The Dynamic Sikhs of Abbotsford

\$15/person

Sikhs from India's Punjab province are BC's second largest religious group after Christians. Of Abbotsford's population of 143,000, 25% are Punjabi. The tour will visit Abbotsford's second oldest Sikh temple. Tour leader Jurgen Schonwetter, professor emeritus at Columbia Bible College, will give an introduction to Sikhism. Local Sikh professor and interpreter Dr. Ram Singh Padwel will tell the Sikh story. Prepare to partake of Punjabi vegetarian food in the temple's lower auditorium.

Tour 2 – Westminster Abbey, Mission BC

\$15/person

The tour will begin with a presentation about the history of the Abbey and its architecture. Canadian Mennonite Bible College alumnus Neil Matthies will direct the tour group in singing in and enjoying the acoustics of the Abbey Cathedral. A short rehearsal is planned before embarking on this tour. Please note that the Abbey does have a dress code. Shorts are not permitted.

Tour 3 – Agricultural Tour – Flavours: Urban and Rural

\$20/person

In a changing world, farmers in BC have had to adapt in order to overcome challenges. This tour will provide an opportunity to meet two farmers who have used different avenues to produce food. The tour participants will view a state of the art greenhouse operation, and also a "consumer friendly" farm where fruits and vegetables are marketed directly to the consumer. The tour will also include taste test opportunities.

Tour 4 – Service Tour – Fraser Valley Gleaners

\$15/person

Spend the afternoon volunteering at the Fraser Valley Gleaners and hear the story and vision for this gleaning project. Begun in 1998, this Christian non-profit organization states its mission as, “converting surplus produce into nutritious food for hungry people.” Participants will serve as volunteers for the afternoon, cutting up vegetables for the dryers, and conclude with a taste test of some of the soup mixes. Tour 5 – Minter Gardens

\$20/person, additional admission fee of \$11.50/person payable at the gate by cash, debit or credit card. The Minter Gardens are nestled against the 7000 foot Mount Cheam. The spectacular show garden covers some 35 acres and includes 11 theme gardens and thousands of brilliant annuals. In July, the rose gardens should be bursting with colour and fragrance. Enjoy a cup of tea surrounded by this magnificent floral display.

Tour 6 – Golf at Poppy Golf Course, Aldergrove BC

Green fee of \$35/person payable at the course by cash, debit or credit card.

Tour 7 – Mountain Hike

\$15/person

Participants will take part in an afternoon of hiking around Weaver Lake in the Hemlock Valley area near Harrison Mills. The hike encircles Weaver Lake for 6.5 km. It includes scaling (with the assistance of wooden steps) a 50 metre rock which drops sheer to the water and offers a good view. Hikers will experience a changing forest surrounding of conifers and deciduous trees, plus shade-loving flowers like coral root. The tour is limited to 14 people. Come prepared for a moderately difficult climb; appropriate foot wear is important.

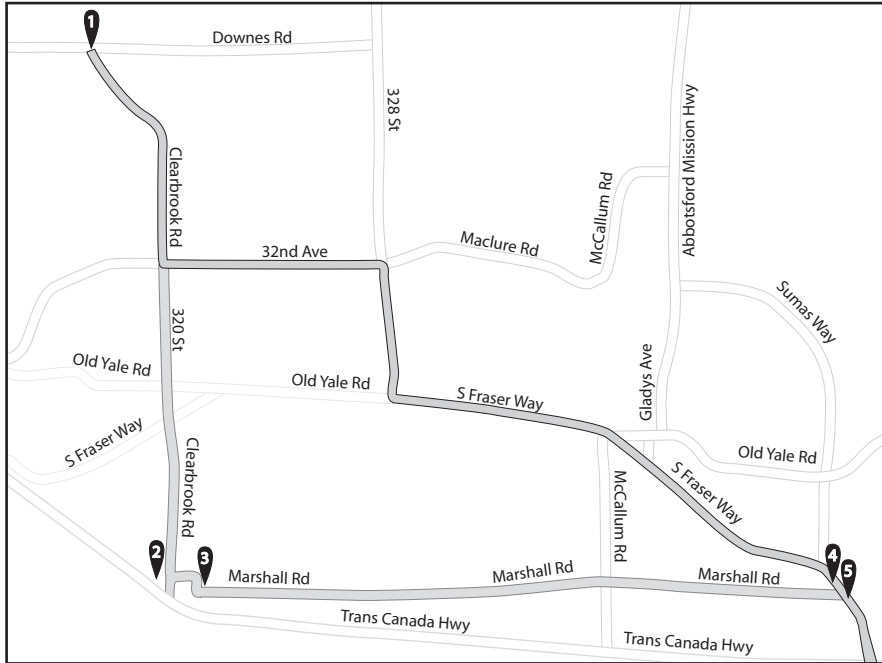
