***The Mar Elias facility*** of the University of Indianapolis represents the first Christian Arab Israeli campus, located in the small Arab village of Ibillin. It is best known as the home of Fr. Elias Chacour [*Blood Brothers*], and a place where Christians and Moslems have lived together for many generations.

***Mar Elias Campus*** has now celebrated 21 years of service to the people of Galilee. Today the complex of seven institutions ranges from kindergarten to university, with over 300 faculty and staff and more than 3,500 students. Father Chacour, the founder and President, leads MEC.
