Youth Ministry Symposium and Lectureship

“Youth and the Quest for a Passionate Church” is the theme of a symposium to be held March 22–24 at Associated Mennonite Biblical Seminary, Elkhart, Ind. Planned especially for pastors who work with youth; educators in high schools, colleges and seminaries; and people working with youth in camps and service agencies, the symposium will feature Kenda Creasy Dean, Ph.D., associate professor of Youth, Church and Culture at Princeton Theological Seminary and author of *The Godbearing Life: The Art of Soul Tending for Youth Ministry*, and *Practicing Passion: Youth and the Quest for a Passionate Church*.

This event, cosponsored by AMBS, Canadian Mennonite University and Goshen College, is designed to clarify a contemporary Anabaptist theology and practice for ministry to, with and by youth.
