Option A: Declaration of Conscience

9.2% of the income taxes you pay are used to support military purposes.

Canadian Mennonites: This tax year, bear witness to the God of Peace as you file your income tax return. You can register your concerns about military taxation in one of two ways:

1. make a clear statement to the government that you object to your taxes being used for military and war purposes
2. make the same statement and also withhold the military portion of your taxes, sending it instead to a peace building organization.
