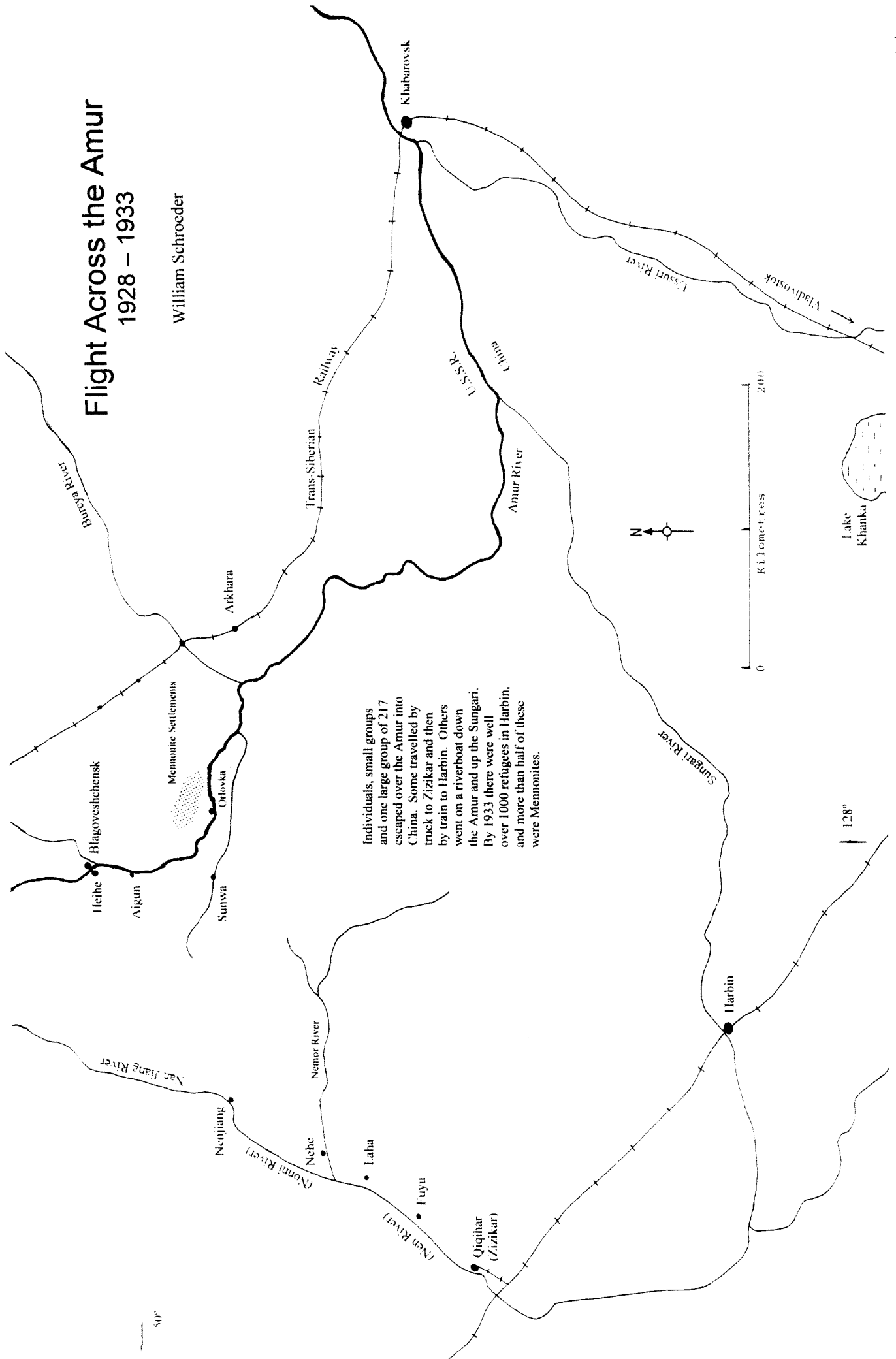


# Flight Across the Amur 1928 - 1933

Individuals, small groups and one large group of 217 escaped over the Amur into China. Some travelled by truck to Zizikar and then by train to Harbin. Others went on a riverboat down the Amur and up the Sungari. By 1933 there were well over 1000 refugees in Harbin, and more than half of these were Mennonites.
