Reader 1: that we stand firm.

Leader: If we are to survive in the world of darkness, it is necessary, says the Apostle Paul, that we put on the whole armour of God.

Reader 1: The belt of truth, buckled around your waist,

Reader 2: The breastplate of Righteousness in place,

Leader: And your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace,

Reader 1: Take up the shield of faith

Reader 2: Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.
