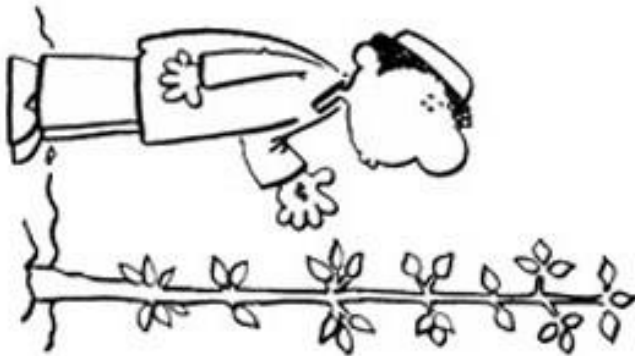

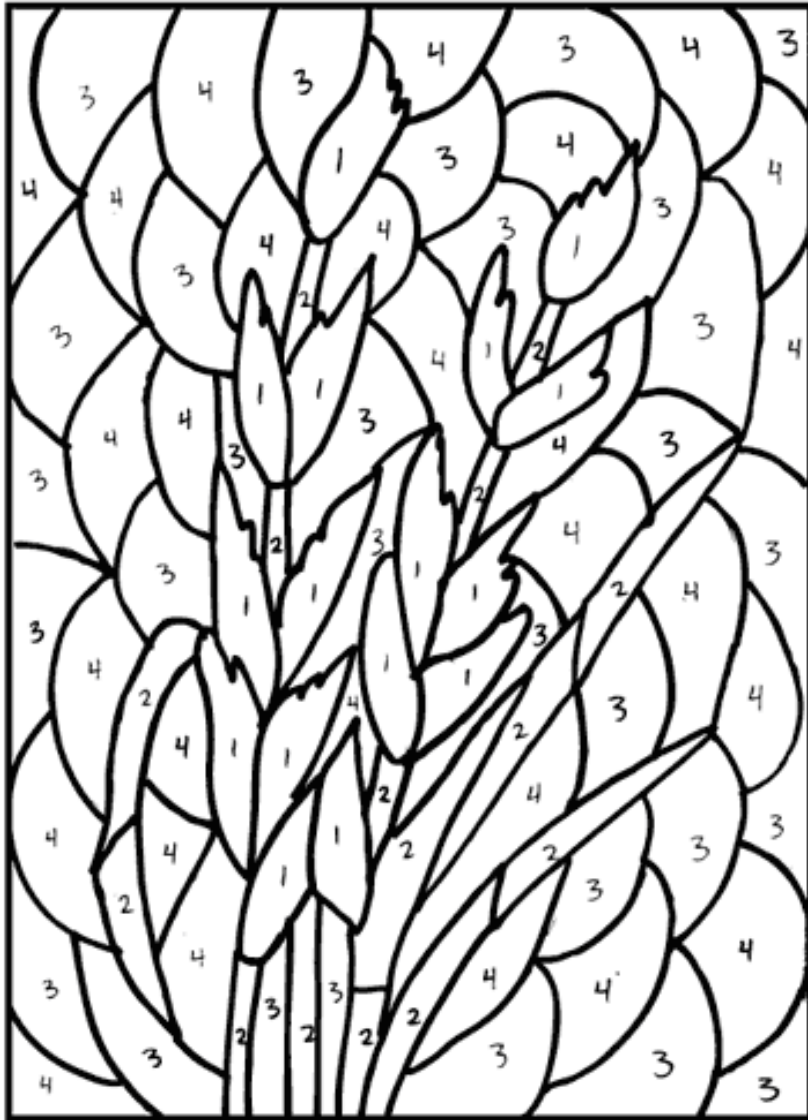

Color in the image by coloring: 1. Yellow 2. Orange 3. Purple 4. Blue

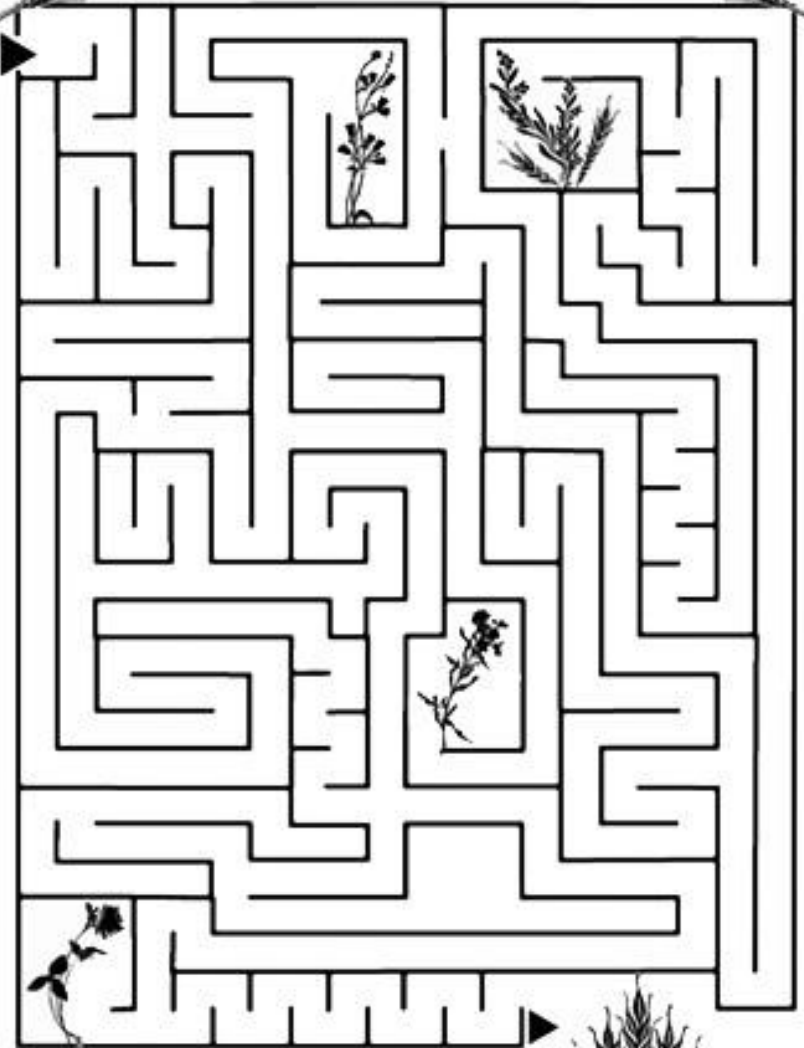


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## Parable The Wheat and the Weeds
